1. Residuary legacy (the residue or part of the residue of an estate).
LEGACY CLAUSE WORDING:
(i) I give share of my real and personal property not hereby or by any codicil hereto specifically disposed of after payment of my debts, pecuniary and specific legacies, funeral and administration expenses and any taxes in respect of my estate to the Polish University Abroad (registered charity number 298510) of 238-246 King Street, London W6 0RF.
(ii) I direct that the receipt of the duly authorised officer of the Polish University Abroad shall be a sufficient discharge for my Executor/Trustees.
2. Pecuniary legacy (a fixed amount of money).
LEGACY CLAUSE WORDING:
(i) I give the sum of £ (pounds) free of tax to the Polish University Abroad (registered charity number 298510) of 238-246 King Street, London W6 0RF.
(ii) I direct that the receipt of the duly authorised officer of the Polish University Abroad shall be a sufficient discharge for my Executor/Trustees.
